
The Fantales Kitchen was the result of an invitation by Australian manufacturer Laminex for YSG Studio to design a beautiful yet durable kitchen utilizing Laminex laminates. With the entire Laminex Color Collection at its disposal, YSG settled on a combination of solid-color laminates alongside classic woodgrains. Named after Fantales, a brand of chocolate-covered soft caramels beloved by many in Australia, the color scheme chosen by the studio is one of warm, velvety toffee browns. The primary task area consists of an L-shaped bench raised above a platform of glass mosaic tiles, set against a wall painted in a mottled, terra-cotta hue. The joinery is faced with laminate in "Burnt Ochre" and the countertop in "Moroccan Clay." A beautifully sculpted kitchen island is finished in three contrasting woodgrain laminates and features a striking decorative band of alternating strips of dark and light. As a whole, the kitchen demonstrates how flexible the laminates are in creating sculptural shapes, curved outlines, and interlocking patterns that define the design.
