







CHEQUERED PATTERNS ARE A RECURRING THEME in this Byron Bay home by YSG Studio. For this master ensuite, they appear in the bathtub surround and, on a larger scale, on the floors, giving the room a luxury hotel room vibe. The team made some crucial structural changes to the layout including closing in a window and removing the corner shower to make space for a custom vanity unit. The enclosed toilet in the corner was resized to make way for the widened bath zone and new deep step that surrounds it. Natural light comes courtesy of a generous skylight, while a sculptural wall disc opposite the bath is fitted with a dimmer to create the perfect relaxed light for bathing. The walls, clad in a Marmorino Venetian plaster, help to gently bounce the light around the room and bronze and brushed copper hardware brings a warm, golden patina. "Responding to our clients' love of browns, Cambia Ash was chosen for its rich caramel shade, providing deep drawers beneath the integrated marble basin flicked with honey streaks," says YSG's co-director Yasmine Ghoniem. Blue elements relieve the brown expanse, including novel blue ceramic pulls in the vanity and a handpainted ewer by Lucy Zaroyko. Shimmering garnet pool mosaics form the ledge at the end of the bath, designed for holding shower products. ysg.studio; @ysg.studio
